

SPORTING CHANCE PRIZE DRAW

Terms and Conditions

1. By entering the prize draw you are agreeing to these prize draw terms and conditions.
2. The prize draw is being run by Sporting Chance Prize Draw Administration Ltd (SCPD).

Eligibility to Enter

Winner Announcement

17. All winners will be notified within 24 hours of the prize draw having taken place, via the email provided during subscription.

18. SCPD will attempt to contact the winner by email up to two times. Also, the results will be posted on the SCPD website.

Receipt of the Prize
